## 'How can these services be Free?'

- 1) **Healthcare professionals volunteer their time to provide quality medical services with compassion and understanding.**
- 2) **Lay volunteers handle patient check-ins, clerical assistance, site maintenance and other tasks to insure an efficient operation.**
- 3) **Entiat Regional Health Clinic is located at 2084 Entiat Way, Entiat Valley Community Services Resource Center in a permanent space of its own.**
- 4) **Generous individuals, businesses and organizations provide contributions of cash, supplies, medicine and equipment.**

## The Plans

Because of the high rate of unemployment in many communities of rural Washington, and the lack of accessible social services, and healthcare we decided that a free health clinic was needed in Entiat that will be able to serve people who currently receive no care or cannot afford to receive care.

Entiat Valley Community Services FoodBank has grown beyond just providing a food bank to include a myriad of services and other programs, providing about thirty services that are not already available in the community.

With the opening of our new program, the Entiat Regional Health Clinic we will be able to make health care accessible to all.

## How does the Clinic Operate!

Entiat Regional Health Clinic provides free, quality health care to low-income Chelan/Douglas county's residents without health insurance or are underinsured in a setting where all patients are treated with respect. The clinic is available twice a month on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday from 5 – 7 pm by appointment for children and adults. Walk-ins are welcomed!

Care is provided by volunteer healthcare providers and other medical professionals. We provide referrals for access to x-rays and lab tests from local hospitals and clinics. Free or low-cost medications are provided to our patients. There are NO narcotics at the clinic or prescribed.

We are able to provide our services free of charge thanks to contributions of cash, supplies, and equipment through the generosity of countless volunteers, donors and community partners.

## Other Services

EVCSFB's Entiat Regional Health Clinic will be offering other healthcare services for adults and children. Those services are as follows:

- Free Dental Clinic for Adults 18 and over
- Sports Physicals for children
- Flu, Vaccine and Immunization Shots
- Hearing and Vision Services and Screening
- Free or low-cost medication assistance (no narcotics)
- Women's Health Services
- Health Screening
- Diabetes – Alzheimer – CPR/1<sup>st</sup> Aid - Fitness Classes
- Health classes, education and awareness

Entiat Regional Health Clinic and EVCSFB partnerships with other healthcare and service agencies enables us to provide referrals, services and other health care and benefits services to those in need.

- SHIBA – supplemental insurance for Medicare clients, assist in applying for SSI (social security) - Medicare
- DSHS Community Connections – food stamps, cash assistance, free phone
- RAM – Free healthcare services
- Washington Healthcare Finder – healthcare insurance
- Mobile Teams International – Dental care for Adults
- Veterans Administration – Vets Services and Benefits
- Catholic Families & Children – CHORE senior home services

Entiat Valley Community Services FoodBank provides food, clothing, meals, transportation to medical appointments for homebound, employment skills, ESL, citizenship, classes, youth and senior support services and other critical services free to those in need. ## The Process

**How do you qualify for services?** Here is some of the basic information you will need to provide:

**PLEASE DO NOT BRING more than one person with you, unless they also have an appointment.**

- 1) Adults and children are seen at the clinic!
- 2) Provide your full name and address. (Please bring ID, driver's license, rent receipt, utility bill with your name and address you live at on it.) DO NOT BRING YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD FOR ID.
- 3) Provide full names, address, phone number and birth dates. Provide name of an emergency contact person.
- 4) Your medical history and your medications you are taking both prescription and over the counter. Date of your last prescription. You may bring all your prescriptions with you and over the counter medication you are taking.
- 5) Name of your doctor or clinic you have been a patient of and when you were last seen.
- 6) Any allergies you may have to bees, food and medication both over the counter and prescriptions.
- 7) Verify that your situation or income level qualifies you for the clinic services, this is a voluntary confirmation.
- 8) Your income does not disqualify you from services of Entiat Regional Health Clinic or EVCSFB.
- 9) If you are having serious or chronic health symptoms or problems CALL 9-1-1 or go to the nearest emergency room to seek treatment.

We look forward to providing healthcare and making it accessible for you and your family.
