Our mission is to better understand and serve the health and wellness needs of the uninsured, low income, and underinsured residents of Entiat and Chelan/Douglas counties with compassion and understanding.

All patients are treated with dignity and respect and are provided with quality care treatment.

Our ability to provide care is based solely upon the willingness of medical professionals to volunteer.

Who: Doctors, PA's, nurses, nurse practitioners, emergency medical technicians, and medical assistants to practice their profession.

What: Volunteers provide free health care to adults and children who are low-income, un- or underinsured and have urgent needs. Volunteers make professional practice decisions regarding diagnosis and treatment based upon basic "standard of care" guidelines and individual procedure preferences or practice limitations.

When: When you have time! Our volunteers choose the day, and frequency of their commitment. We care for a broad spectrum of people including children, the homeless, migrant workers, elderly, Veterans and working poor.

Where: Volunteer opportunities are available throughout the year at our location at 2084 Entiat Way, EVCS Resource Center on the 2nd & 4th Thursday, twice a month. ** With your help we can extend our services to twice a month or more!*

Why: More than two million in the Pacific Northwest live below the federal poverty levels. These people cannot afford basic health care. Many more families because of the high rate of unemployment in many communities lack health insurance. Others earn too much to receive welfare, but too little to afford the cost of health care or insurance, such as supplemental insurance for the elderly on SSI. When health care is needed many seek services at the emergency rooms at local hospitals. Others wait until their health or illness becomes severe and debilitating. Over the last three years our hospital emergency rooms have seen a significant number who could not afford to pay for their medical services, as a result \$13 million dollars in unpaid medical services for 2012.
